PRODUCT BACKGROUND

Individual amenity bottles have become an expected item in guest rooms at hotels and are regarded as convenient, complimentary gifts. The use of millions of amenity bottles, however, is detrimental to the environment, and therefore serves as an ideal opportunity for a more sustainable alternative.

> In order to divert thousands of pounds of waste annually, the Comfort Inn & Suites Boston/Logan International Airport provides amenity dispensers in each guestroom to offer high quality bath products.

PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION

Amenity dispensers were installed during initial building construction. Both dispensers and liquids are the product of Dispenser Amenities and the shampoo and shower gels are of the "WindRiver" Salon Products line. "WindRiver" products are environmentally friendly, as they are biodegradable and are available in larger bottles to avoid excess waste.

Instead of replacing partially used individual bottles daily, dispensers a refilled and are always topped off upon quest check out.





OUTLOOK

Amenity dispensers create benefits along the entire supply and production chain and are far superior in terms of sustainability. Soap and shampoo are not wasted as they are when half used bottles are disposed of, and thousands of pounds of plastic are diverted from landfills annually.
