



Getting there

- Saruni Rhino is **a 2 hours' drive north** from Saruni Samburu;
- Multiple airstrips for private air charter throughout Sera Community Conservancy (15 mins' flight from Kalama);
- Kalama airstrip for domestic flights;
- Road transfers from Saruni Samburu included in package.



- **Perfect oasis** amidst the arid rangelands of the north;
- Unique location; amongst doum palms dotted along a dry river bed (the Kauro 'lugga');
- First community conservancy in Africa to own and operate a sanctuary dedicated to the conservation of the critically endangered black rhino;
- First time the black rhino is back to Northern Kenya after 30 years;
- First time black rhino tracking experience available in Kenya;
- Elite-trained anti-poaching units with state-of-the-art technology;
- Samburu guides who share their local, authentic insight and culture;
- Prime game viewing, abundant wildlife and bird life and rare species.






The Experience
