

Taking Public Transportation to the Rose Parade

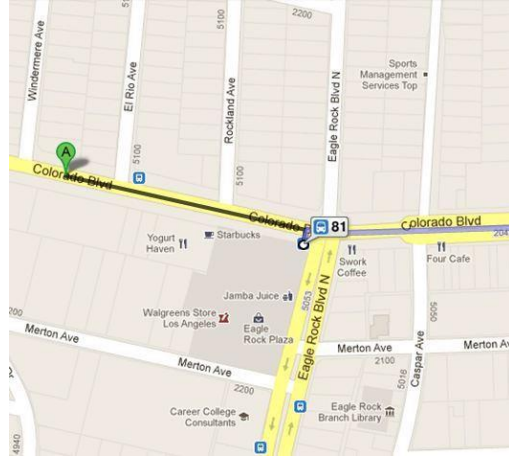
Getting to the Rose Parade by public transportation is by far one of the best choices a guest can make. Here are a few reasons:

3. The buses and the Metro (train) run more often or at least every 15 minutes.

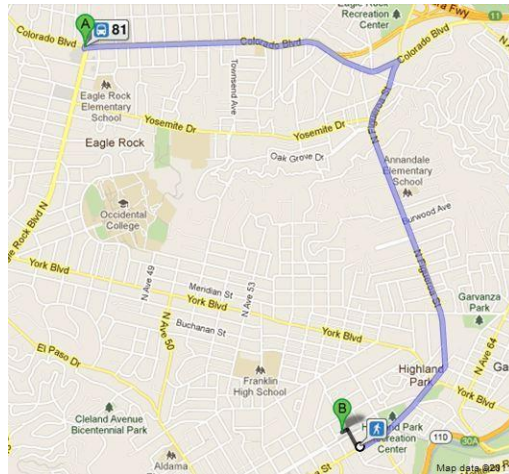

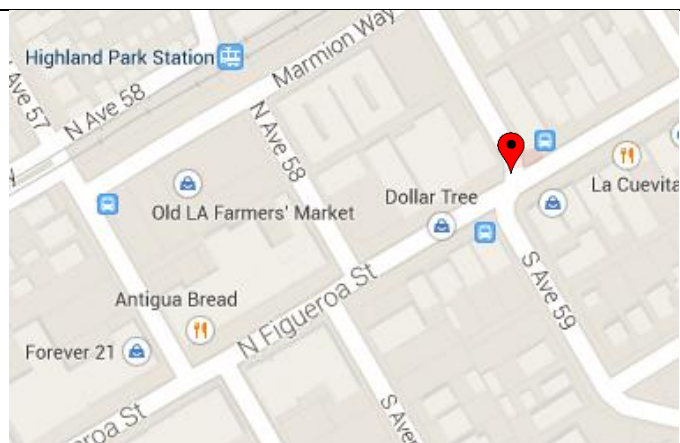
- 1 Turn Right on Colorado Blvd. and walk toward the **Colorado Blvd / Eagle Rock Blvd. Bus Stop** 2 min



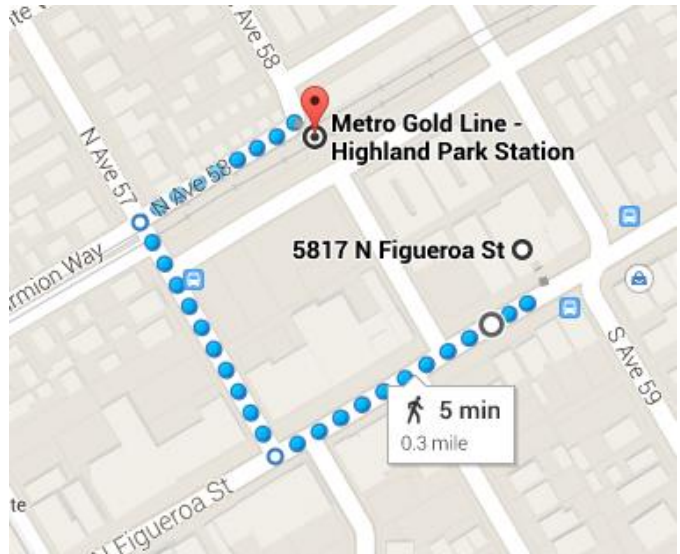
- 2 Take the Bus - **Metro Local Line 81** heading toward **Downtown LA.** 16 min



- 3 Get off at **Figueroa & Avenue 59** Bus Stop

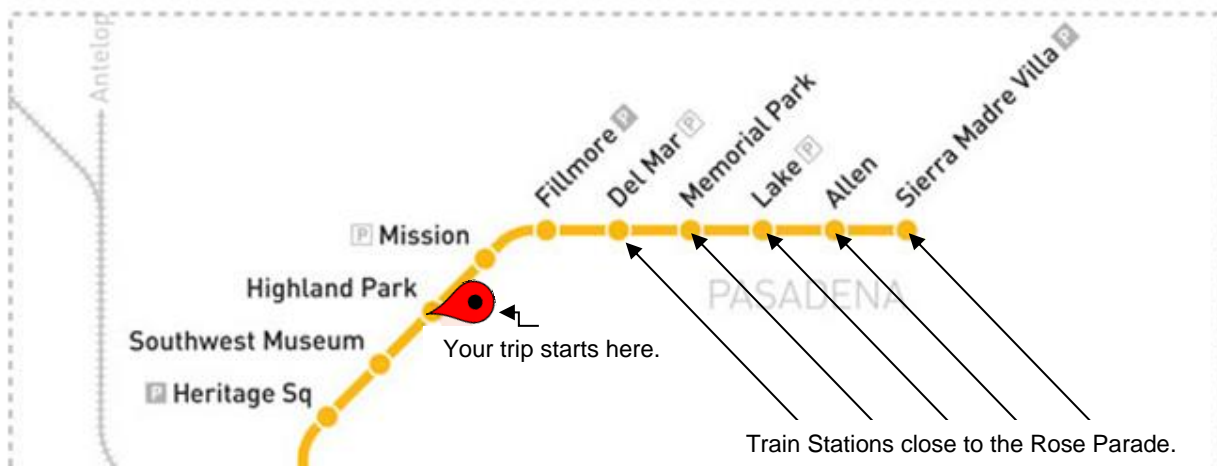


- 4 Walk toward **Highland Park Gold Line Metro Station**
4 min



- 5 Take **Metro Gold Line Train** heading toward **AZUSA** 15 min

- 6 **Get-off at the Metro Station that is closest to your assigned seats.** Please see list of stations below



- 7 Walk toward your assigned seats on **Colorado Boulevard**.

Total trip time should take about 40 minutes
