Included

- Supervision and assistance for all necessary paperwork in Kenya;
- Transport for the couple to complete all official requirements in Nairobi;
- All fees for the marriage;
- Transport and fees for the Marriage Registrar;
- The civil ceremony (once the license has been obtained, the Marriage Registrar can marry the couple in a civil ceremony and a marriage certificate issued by the Republic of Kenya with full validity is signed and given to the married couple);
- A private candle-lit dinner;
- A bottle of French champagne;
- Homemade Saruni wedding cake.

Excluded

- A traditional Maasai or Samburu blessing at US\$650;
- Professional wedding cake from US\$400;
- Wedding photographer (price upon request);
- Professional flower arrangement from US\$300 at Saruni Samburu & US\$400 at Saruni Mara;
- Additional French champagne, premium wines and spirits.

Requirements for a wedding in Kenya

- Wedding couple must spend at least one working day in Nairobi before the wedding.
- The wedding couple must go to the registry office in person.
- The wedding can only take place after a minimum of a four-day stay in Kenya.
- Original passport and birth certificate are required for registration.
- A civil registration is required in Nairobi prior to other ceremonies elsewhere in Kenya.

Paperwork required before the wedding

- Valid passports for the bride and the groom (copies & originals);
- 2 colour copies passport size photos for the bride and the groom;
- Birth certificates for the bride and the groom (copies & original);
- An affidavit that the bride and groom are of single status;
- Certificate of NO Impediment to Marriage (in the case of a single person*);
- Death certificate (in the case of a widowed person) (copies & original);
- Divorce Decree Absolute (in the case of a divorced person) (copies & original);
- Return air ticket/valid visa/work permit;
- A letter stating the full names, address and occupation of the bride and the groom, and those of their parents;
- Both parties MUST present themselves at the Registrar's office to apply for a special permit.

* British nationals are required to provide a letter from their local Registration and Coroner's office stating they are single plus the affidavit and other documents as stated on the wedding package.

NB: Any document in a language other than English MUST be translated and legally verified as true translation. Please ensure that the translated documents are signed and stamped by your local embassy in Nairobi.
