Chef's Corner



Executive Chef **Imre Maraczi**, originally from Budapest with experience in Europe's finest culinary facilities.

1/2 cup butter

- 1 cup white sugar
- 2 eggs
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1/3 cup unsweetened cocoa powder
- 1/2 cup all-purpose flour
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1 packet marshmallows
- Caramel sauce
- Whipped cream
- 1/4 teaspoon baking powder

Frosting:

- 3 tablespoons butter, softened
- 3 tablespoons unsweetened cocoa powder
- 1 tablespoon honey
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1 cup confectioners' sugar
- Vanilla ice cream



DIRECTIONS:

1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C). Grease and flour an 8-inch square pan.

2. In a large saucepan, melt 1/2 cup butter. Remove from heat, and stir in sugar, eggs, and 1 teaspoon vanilla. Beat in 1/3 cup cocoa, 1/2 cup flour, salt, and baking powder. Spread batter into prepared pan.

3. Bake in preheated oven for 25 to 30 minutes. Do not overcook. 4. To Make Frosting: Combine 3 tablespoons softened butter, 3 tablespoons cocoa, honey, 1 teaspoon vanilla extract, and 1 cup confectioners' sugar. Stir until smooth. Frost brownies while they are still warm.

5. Once frosting is done cut the marshmallows into smaller chunks, and cover the brownies with the pieces

6. Brush or spread melted dark chocolate on the marshmallows, (do not cover fully)

7. Leave to rest for 45 minutes

8. Portion them to your liking and serve with vanilla ice cream and caramel sauce.
