The Whittier Fire

The Whittier Fire is a wildfire taking place in the Los Padres National Forest in the southern backcountry of Santa Barbara County. The fire began on Sat, July 8 near Lake Cachuma (8 1/2 miles east of Santa Ynez) and burned south, away from Santa Ynez. Roads

Hwy 154 (the San Marcos Pass) remains closed from Foothill Road in Santa Barbara to the intersection of Hwy 246. However, Hwy 101 through Goleta is open to traffic and generally moving well.

If approaching the valley from the south, simply stay on Hwy 101 and exit at the other end of Hwy 246 in Buellton. Turn right on Hwy 246 and follow the road through Buellton and Solvang. Then, turn left onto Edison Street when just past the casino and we're one block up on the left.

Air Quality

We are also closely monitoring the air quality and are happy to report that the skies remain blue save for the occasional passing haze.

The Alamo Fire

The Alamo Fire is taking place in remote canyons at the northern borders of Santa Barbara County. We remain unaffected by this fire which is located ~60 miles to our north.

If approaching the valley from the north, you should find Hwy 101 to be open and generally moving well.
