Job Summary

Maintain a clean and appealing guest room according to policy standards.

Duties and Responsibilities

General

- 1. Advises manager or front desk of rooms ready for occupancy.
- 2. Change bed linen daily.
- 3. Vacuum carpeting. Sweeps, scrubs, waxes, and polishes floors.
- 4. Cleans carpets, upholstered furniture, and draperies.
- 5. Washes walls, ceiling, and woodwork.
- 6. Washes windows, door panels, and sills.
- 7. Empties wastebaskets. Transports trash and waste to disposal areas.
- 8. Dust all furniture (picture frames, bed frames, lamps, TVs, dressers, etc.).
- 9. Remove fingerprints and smudges (ex. mirrors, shiny surfaces, windows, etc).
- 10. Thoroughly clean the bathroom area wash shower stall, sink, floor, toilet, etc.
- 11. Replenishes supplies such as drinking glasses, toiletries and writing supplies.
- 12. Replaces light bulbs.
- 13. Make sure that the standard room set-up is complied with.

- 14. Report immediately all damage found in a room.
- 15. Report immediately all missing items in room. Report immediately personal guest items found in vacant rooms.
- 16. Notify Executive Housekeeper of all rollaways or cribs in rooms for pick-up and storage.
- 17. Take responsibility for pass key and make sure it is turned in daily.
- 18. Turn in immediately all "lost and found" items to Executive Housekeeper.
- 19. Report immediately to the Executive Housekeeper:

No luggage

No service needed.

Sleep outs.

Extra guests.

Anything unusual.

- 20. Shut off all lights, TVs and set air conditioners to 70 degrees in summer, set heat to 78 in winter when leaving room..
- 21. Assist Executive Housekeeper in any additional cleaning chores she may assign (common areas, event spaces, etc).

Responsible For:

Linens, blankets, and room supplies; equipment, vacuums, etc.
