

Scotch Whisky

Ardbeg, Islay, 10 year old ~ Heavy peat with notes of citrus, spice, espresso, banana, and dried fruit (11.) **Balvenie Doublewood, Highland, 14 year old** ~ nutty sweetness, cinnamon spiciness and a delicate layer of sherry (12.) **Bowmore 12 year old** ~ subtle lemon and honey, balanced beautifully by Bowmore's trademark peaty smokiness (13.) **Chivas Regal, Blended 12 Year Old Scotch** ~ "The blend for grown-ups;" very refined (9.) **Cragganmore, Speyside, 12 year old** ~ Rich honey, stone fruits, chestnuts, walnuts, almonds with peppery smoke finish (14.) **Cutty Sark Blended Scotch Whisky** ~ *Clean; balanced & lively with vanilla ice cream & caramel* (6.5) **Dewar's 18 year old** ~ *sweet and mellow Whisky with notes of butterscotch and almonds* (18.) **Dewar's Highlander Honey** ~ sarsaparilla & a Scotch-like smokiness, which cuts the intense sweetness (6.5) **Dewar's White Label** ~ Scottish heather & honey with delicate notes of unripened pear & a hint of oak (8.5) **Glenlivet**, **Speyside**, **12 year old** ~ *Flowery*, *peachy*, *notes of vanilla*, *delicate balance between sweetness* & *malty dryness* (14.) **Glenfiddich**, **Speyside**, **12 year old** ~ Sweet, fruity notes develops into butterscotch, cream, malt and subtle oak flavours (14.)**Glenfiddich Experimental Series IPA Cask, Speyside** ~ Rich vanilla toffee and lemon cream, oaky spice, cocoa and floral (13.) Haig Club Single Grain Scotch ~ Coconut creamy sweetness, butterscotch, and a mouth-watering spiciness (8.) **Hedonism**, Scotch Grain Whisky ~ Elegant flavours of vanilla cream, toffee, coconut (22.) **Highland Park Dark Orgins** ~ Dry peat at first, mellowing out to cherries & warm dark chocolate (16.) Highland Park, Orknay, 12 year old ~ Grilled orange, notes of toast and green tea with jasmine. A touch of sweetness (14.) **J & B Blended Scotch Whisky** ~ Europe's most popular Scotch whisky. It is a blend of 42 different whiskies (8.) Johnny Walker Black, Blended Scotch ~ blend of whiskies aged a minimum of 12 yrs from the four corners of Scotland (10.)**Lagavulin**, Islay, 16 year old ~ Long, spicy finish, figs, dates, peat smoke, vanilla (18.) **Laphroiag, Islay, 10 year old** ~ Suprising sweetness with hints of salt and layers of peatiness (14.) **MacAllan Sherry Oak, Highland, 12 year old** ~ *Sherry cask aged, notes of sugar & butter* (12.) **Oban, Highland, 14 year old** ~ Rich, smokey, medicinal notes, citrus with smooth sweetness (14.) **Port Charlotte Single Malt** ~ *Initial smoke followed by an immense creaminess, then notes of sherbet lemon emerge* (13.) **Talisker, Skye, 10 year old** ~ Full bodied with huge plumes of smoke and volcanic, peppery peat. Intense. (16.) **Spice Tree, Scotch Malt Whisky** ~ *Gingernut biscuits, toffee spices, herbal, vanilla, very rich and peppery* (12.)



Bourbon Whiskey

1792 Barrel Select, aged 8 years ~ *tannic and peppery, with a heavily woody flavor profile and hint of maple* (9.) **Angel's Envy, Port Finish** ~ vanilla, ripe fruit, maple syrup, toast and bitter chocolate (11.) Bakers Small Batch, aged 7 years ~ nutty, with good grip. Plenty of tangy fruit with vanilla spice and rounded char (12.) **Basil Hayden Small Batch aged 8 years** ~ spicy, peppery, honey, light-bodied, gentle bite (12.) **Black Button Four Grain** ~ 60% Corn, 20% Wheat, 9% Rye, 11% Malted Barely; all sourced from Upstate NY (8.) **Blanton's Single Barrel, aged 10 years** ~ burnt sugar, orange, and cloves balanced with vanilla, honey, and citrus (13.) **Booker's Single Barrel**, aged 7 years ~ oak tannin and smoky vanilla to lighter tones of mocha and coffee (15.) **Bowman Brothers Virginia Bourbon** ~ *hints of vanilla and oak, toffee, apples, & maple* (10.) **Buffalo Trace** ~ 3 grain whiskey aged in new oak. Classic taste (9.) **Bulleit** ~ medium-full body & a chewy dried fruit pastry, mineral & warming spice flourish (10.) **Clyde May "Alabama Style" Whiskey** ~ *unique barreling with dried apples* (11.) **Eagle Rare 10 Year** ~ bold, dry, oaky flavors with notes of candied almonds & very rich coco (9.) **Evan Williams Single Barrel** ~ *tropical fruits, sea-salt caramels, peanuts, and some spice* (9.) High West American Prairie ~ rich and earthy on the palate with well balanced flavors of candy corn, honey nougat and sweet corn bread biscuits (9.) Hudson Baby Bourbon ~ warm finish with notes of marzipan and roasted corn (14.) **Jim Beam Black Label** ~ *full-Bodied, heavier caramel, well-balanced, rich & flavorful* (9.) **Jim Beam Single Barrel Bourbon** ~ well balanced attributes of oak, vanilla, and caramel (10.) **Jim Beam White Label** ~ toasty oak and resin with a some sweetness (6.) **Knob Creek Small Batch, aged 9 years** ~ *spicy & sweet, long dry finish* (11.) **Larceny, Kentucky Straight Bourbon** ~ wheat replaces rye for a great nose (9.5) **Maker's Mark** ~ rich & full; notes of rye & spice, barley malt, nut oil with butterscotch & vanilla (10.) Maker's Cask Strength ~ notes of caramel, toasted nuts & cinnamon. Hints of allspice, dark fruit & molasses (14.) Wild Turkey Single Barrel ~ medium-long finish with hearty notes of rye & leather (15.) Woodford Reserve, Barrel Select, aged 6 years ~ triple distilled, high rye content (11.)



Irish Whisky

2 Gingers ~ smooth, malty and slightly sweet, blended Irish Whiskey smooth (6.)
Bushmills Black Bush ~ combines malt whiskey matured in Oloroso Sherry casks with a sweet, batch-distilled grain whiskey (8.)
Bushmills Red Bush ~ triple-distilled and matured to perfection in bourbon casks (8.)
Jameson ~ good body with notes of orchard fruits, both fresh & cooked with a little vanilla cream (8.)
Jameson Black Barrel ~ blend of rich pot still & grain whiskey that is matured in a mixture of sherry casks and bourbon barrels (7.)
Jameson Caskmates ~finished in stout-seasoned whiskey casks; notes of cocoa, coffee and butterscotch confirm the stout influence (7.)
Powers Small Batch ~ butter & honey, grains & vanilla (7.)
Red Breast ~ rich and spicy, with notes of dried sultanas and figs. Toasted wood with hints of vanilla (8.)
Tullamore Dew ~ quite vegetal and long with notes of caramel and toffee (8.)

Canadian Whiskey

Seagram's VO ~ spicy & creamy, medium-bodied with honey, caramel & coffee (6.)
Crown Royal ~ delicately smooth & creamy, with hints of oak & the sweet flavor of vanilla (8.)
Black Velvet ~ medium-short & fading. Peppery with lots of heat. Ripe black fruit, caramel, & burnt sugar (5.5)
Collingwood ~ signature Canadian sweetness with more depth (8.5)
Canadian Club Rye ~ balance of rye spiciness, caramel & oak notes, smooth & creamy (7.)
J.P. Wiser's Canadian Rye ~ oak, toasted grain, & toffee (8.)

Flavored Whiskey

Bird Dog Jalapeno Honey ~ A light, sweet honeyed aroma with a zesty, crisp jalapeno blast (7.) Catskill Provisions Honey Infused Whiskey, Long Eddy, NY ~ 80% local rye, 20% malted barley, local honey (8.) Iron Smoke Apple Wood Smoked Whiskey, Fairport, NY ~ deepness of oak & subtle warm apple wood finish (10.) Jack Daniels Tennessee Fire ~ crafted with Old No. 7 Whiskey; naturally infused with a red hot cinnamon liqueur (8.) Jack Daniels Tennessee Honey ~ spiced honey liqueur, it's got spice, sweetness, floral undertones and a long smooth finish (8.) Rattle Snake Rosie's Apple Pie, Fairport, NY ~ updated take on the traditional apple pie moonshines (10.)

Ryes, Wheats, and everything else

Bernheim Original, Kentucky Wheat Whiskey ~ aged for 5 years, toasty & mellow (8.)
Jim Beam Rye ~ spicy yet sweet, caramelized brown-notes (8.)
Jack Daniels ~ balance of sweet and oak, concentrates at mid-palate (8.)
Knob Creek, Small Batch Rye ~ 95% Rye, 5% malted barley, smooth (10.)
Nikka Coffey Grain ~ Sweet, fruity flavors of melon, grapefruit & thick syrup, balanced by crunchy biscuits & fresh vanilla (14.)
Seagram's 7 ~ a nose offering smoky, herbal and honey/maple elements; smooth bodied, apricot flavored, buttery delight (6.)
Suntory Hibiki Harmony ~ light, approachable and moreish with enticing notes of orange peel and white chocolate (13.)
Templeton Small Batch Rye ~ spicy, with a smooth, clean finish (9.)
Tin Cup ~ cinnamon toast, tannic raisins & soft caramel sweetness (9.)
Woodford Reserve Rye ~ clove, rye, mint, molasses, sorghum & honey. Hints of apple & malt (9.)
