



Sparkling Wines

Glass / Bottle

Bin 101 **La Marca Prosecco ~ Veneto, Italy**

\$11 / \$36

This sparkling wine is a pale, golden straw in color. Bubbles are full textured and persistent. On the nose the wine brings fresh citrus with hints of honey and white flowers. The flavor is fresh and clean, with ripe citrus, lemon, green apple, and touches of grapefruit, minerality, and some toast. The finish is light, refreshing, and crisp.

Bin 102 **Segura Viudas Cava Brut ~ Barcelona, Spain**

\$7 / \$24

This brut has aromas of white fruit and citrus, along with tropical and light floral notes. Notes of lime and pineapple, together with a balanced acidity round it out.

Bin 103 **Domaine Carneros Brut 2012 ~ Napa Valley, California**

\$58

Beautiful aromatic notes of fresh flowers, lychee, white peach and pear make this wine irresistible. The delicate nose belies the round, full palate and exceptionally creamy finish.

Bin 104 **Veuve Clicquot Brut Yellow Label ~ Champagne, France**

\$105

Tightly knit, focused by robust acidity and a streak of minerality, this offers subtle notes of white peach, anise, biscuit and kumquat. The refined finish echoes a smoky note.

Bin 105 **Nicolas Feuillatte Brut Rosé ~ Champagne, France**

\$95

Blended from 90% red grapes with a dollop of Chardonnay, this wine explodes in the glass with vivid aromas and flavors of raspberry, strawberry and red currants.

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| Bin 201 | Barone Fini Pinot Grigio 2016 ~ Alto Adige, Italy | \$6 / \$21 |
| | This opens with aromas of subtle floral notes and lemon mist. Round fruit fills the mouth with ripe, juicy flavors of honeydew melon and ripe apples. Bright acidity balanced with warm minerality create a lingering, crisp finish. | |
| Bin 202 | Adelsheim Pinot Gris 2015 ~ Willamette Valley, Oregon | \$29 |
| | Aromas of white peach, minerality, and pear blossom appear up front. Gentle creaminess lends a rich, mouth-filling texture and long finish; crisp and clean. | |
| Bin 203 | Santa Margherita Pinot Grigio 2016 ~ Trentino-Alto Adige, Italy | \$62 |
| | Straw yellow in color with a clean, crisp fragrance and intense, yet elegant, hints of quince. Fresh, harmonious fruit set off by slight sweetness with a long finish full of delicate, tangy flavor. | |
| Bin 204 | A to Z Wineworks Pinot Gris 2015 ~ Oregon | \$36 |
| | Aromas of honeysuckle, lemon zest, nutmeg and wet stone developing into richer aromas of lychee, beeswax and melon. Juicy and pure with bright citrus fruit flavors and mineral notes. | |

Albariño & Vermentino

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| Bin 301 | Martin Codax Albariño 2015 ~ Rias Baixas, Spain | \$29 |
| | A refreshing, medium-bodied white that pairs extremely well with shellfish. Rich, elegant, balanced with a touch of crisp acidity. | |
| Bin 302 | Argiolas Costamilino Vermentino 2016 ~ Sardinia, Italy | \$26 |
| | Hints at aromas of pine and mint coupled with ripe stone fruit and sweet citrus. The palate is at once vibrant and textural and finishes with lingering acidity. | |

Sauvignon Blanc

Glass / Bottle

- Bin 401** **Brancott Estate Sauvignon Blanc 2016 ~ Marlborough, New Zealand** \$7 / \$24
Aromas of sweet ripe fruit reminiscent of ripe gooseberry, with Golden stone fruit and rock melon. The wine displays full fruit intensity with hints of pungency complementing the ripe fruit flavors and balancing well with the crisp acidity of the style.
- Bin 402** **Nautilus Estate Sauvignon Blanc 2016 ~ Marlborough, New Zealand** \$34
A textural wine with impressive weight, flavor and intensity. Peach, apple and grapefruit are superseded by lees and a hint of spice. There's decent acidity on show here with just enough concentration and balance.
- Bin 403** **Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc ~ Marlborough, New Zealand** \$65
The nose is bright with aromas of kaffir lime and grapefruit. A generous palate reveals ripe citrus, stone fruit and lemongrass flavors balanced by crunchy acidity.
- Bin 404** **Domaine François Crochet, Sancerre Exils 2015 ~ Loire Valley, France** \$47
On the nose aromatic citrus fruits and orange peel jump from the glass. On the palate it is fresh and structured with striking minerality.

Riesling

- Bin 501** **Lakewood Semi-Dry Riesling 2015 ~ Finger Lakes, New York** \$7 / \$24
Opens with bright aromas of pear, citrus, and a hint of peach. The palate is balanced nicely with a touch of sweetness and moderate acidity.
- Bin 502** **Hosmer Dry Riesling 2016 ~ Cayuga Lake, New York** \$8 / \$26
Nose begins with citrus blossom and Fuji apple going to bright fruit flavors of honey crisp apple, lemon zest and lime in the front palate finishing with subtle cedar spice and mouthwatering acidity.
- Bin 503** **Forge Dry Riesling 2014 ~ Finger Lakes, New York** \$32
This has a plump core of yellow apple and melon flavors, offset by hints of lemon zest and apple skin along the edges. A light fennel note leaves a tangy hint on the finish as this opens steadily in the glass.
- Bin 504** **Dr. Konstantin Frank Semi-Dry Riesling 2015 ~ Finger Lakes, New York** \$34
Medium intensity with dominant characters of sweet citrus, peach and floral notes. The light sweetness is well balanced by a zesty acidity. A versatile refreshing wine to enjoy on its own or

Chardonnay

- Bin 601 Kendall Jackson Vintner's Reserve Chardonnay 2015 ~ California** \$9 / \$30
This estate grown Chardonnay showcases flavors & aromas of peach, gala apple, lemon, lime, & pear layered with butterscotch & subtle toasty oak. Dry & balanced with a long, creamy finish.
- Bin 602 Cakebread Cellars Chardonnay 2015 ~ Napa Valley, California** \$85
Fresh, fragrant, apple, melon and pear aromas with a hint of oak spice. Rich and mouth filling on the palate. Smooth, beautifully balanced, yellow apple, nectarine and honeydew melon flavors segue into a long, succulent finish enhanced by refreshing mineral and spicy oak tones.
- Bin 603 Sonoma-Cutrer Chardonnay 2014 ~ Russian River Valley, California** \$42
Fragrant aromas of ripe pears, pineapple, and acacia blossom; crisp and firm structure. Flavor notes of fresh red apple, peach, apricot and melon with just a hint of oak, leading to a rich, long-lasting finish.
- Bin 605 Bodega Catena Zapata Chardonnay Catena Alta 2015 ~ Mendoza, Argentina** \$59
The nose offers ripe white fruit aromas such as pears and peaches that are interwoven with delicate citrus and floral notes, such as Jasmine. The palate shows rich and concentrated ripe pear, apple and apricot flavors with a light note of minerality. The wine finishes long and complex with crisp, mineral acidity.
- Bin 605 Louis Jadot Pouilly-Fuisse Chardonnay 2015 ~ Burgunday, France** \$59
Emerald gold tones which reflect a wine of finesse and distinction; the tasting is harmonious, fresh, full of flavors with hazelnuts, toasted almonds, grapefruit and lemon aromas.
- Bin 606 Duckhorn Chardonnay 2014 ~ Napa Valley, California** \$64
Emerald gold tones which reflect a wine of finesse and distinction; the tasting is harmonious, fresh, full of flavors with hazelnuts, toasted almonds, grapefruit and lemon aromas.

Rosé

- Bin 701 Domaine Gueissard Rose 2016 ~ Côtes de Provence, France** \$6 / \$21
A salmon color with nuances of dark pink, red fruit aromas such as raspberry, wild strawberry, and some note of lychee. Fresh, rich, and long-lasting in the mouth.
- Bin 702 Lamoreaux Landing Dry Rose 2016 ~ Seneca Lake, New York** \$26
Aromas of spring crisp cherry blossom complement a cool, fleshy melon mouthfeel. Edged with peppery, mouthwatering zing, the finish quenches with ripe, brambleberries and freshly whipped cream.

Red Wines

Pinot Noir

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| Bin 801 | Castle Rock Pinot Noir 2015 ~ Willamette, Oregon
On the palate it gives flavors of berries, cinnamon, black cherry, sweet vanilla oak, and floral notes, with a long velvety finish. | \$7 / \$22 |
| Bin 802 | Meiomi Pinot Noir 2016 ~ California
Fruit aromas of bright strawberry and jammy fruit, mocha, and vanilla, along with toasty oak notes. Expressive boysenberry, blackberry, dark cherry, juicy strawberry, and toasty mocha flavors lend complexity and depth. The well-integrated oak provides structure and depth seldom seen in Pinot Noir. | \$59 |
| Bin 803 | Francis Coppola Director's Pinot Noir 2013 ~ Russian River, California
Well-concentrated, fruit forward & silky in texture, fragrance of spiced plums & wild raspberries. Sweet juicy cherries & pomegranate on a rich finish with vanilla & toasted oak. | \$58 |
| Bin 804 | Forge Cellars Classique Pinot Noir ~ Seneca Lake, New York
Initially smoky and closed, but time and aeration bring out penetrating black-cherry and berry flavors. Seductively perfumed with a lingering finish nuanced by spice and violet petals. High-toned acidity and fine upright tannins. | \$46 |
| Bin 805 | J. Lohr Pinot Noir 2014 ~ Monterey County, California
Ripe notes of black cherry, strawberry and dried herbs lifted by vanilla spice. Plump red fruit on the palate finishes with a touch of talc and rhubarb. The clean acidity invites a wide range of food pairings. | \$34 |
| Bin 806 | Elouan Pinot Noir 2015 ~ Oregon
Ripe cranberry, sweet cinnamon and fresh cherry create an inviting bouquet, with a subtle earthiness. The flavor profile shows red plum, bright cherry, minerality, dusty earth, and a hint of sweet tobacco, creating rustic layers of flavor with soft refined tannins. | \$59 |
| Bin 807 | Joseph Phelps Freestone Vineyards Pinot Noir 2014 ~ Sonoma Coast, California
Aromatic red cherry and raspberry along with savory spices, fresh cut herbs and floral notes. Expressive red plum, currants and cranberries dominate the palate followed by white pepper. | \$59 |
| Bin 808 | Emeritus Hallberg Ranch Pinot Noir 2013 ~ Russian River Valley, California
This is a joyful wine that retains its freshness yet remains reserved. It is lively with vibrant acidity that carries red fruit aromas of strawberry and raspberry. On the palate, snappy blackberry, red berry, spice, sage and underbrush notes. Ends with a mineral edge that holds the flavors. | \$75 |

Merlot

Glass / Bottle

- Bin 901** **Columbia Crest Grand Estates Merlot 2013** ~ Columbia Valley, Washington **\$8 / \$26**
Rich, aromatic profile with notes of chocolate and dark cherries. The complex fruit flavors are followed by a smooth, velvety finish.
- Bin 902** **Francis Coppola Diamond Collection Blue Label Merlot 2014** ~ California **\$34**
Merlot co-fermented with a small amount of Syrah to intensify the color & add depth to the flavor. After fermentation is complete, the wine is aged in French oak barrels, which lend a soft vanilla bean aroma & toasty flavors.
- Bin 903** **Ferrari-Carano Merlot 2012** ~ Sonoma County, California **\$63**
Complex nose of fresh cherries, pomegranate & rhubarb pie, flavors of strawberry, brown sugar, crème brûlée. Medium-bodied mid-palate, mouth-watering tannins, and long, smooth finish.
- Bin 904** **Miner Stagecoach Merlot 2012** ~ Napa Valley, California **\$75**
Loaded with rich ripe fruit and spice notes with touches of tasty oak, this Merlot has a nice grip from fine tannins on the lengthy finish.

Reds Blends

- Bin 1001** **Kermit Lynch Côtes du Rhône 2015** ~ Rhône Valley, France **\$24**
The approachable palate is fruit forward with ripe notes of red fruit and spice. There are also hints of earth that help balance out the sweetness of the fruit. Blend of Grenache, Syrah, and Cinsault.
- Bin 1002** **Franciscan Magnificent 2013** ~ Napa Valley, California **\$92**
Dark cherry, plum, baking spices, and coffee weave into a complex aroma. The wine opens with ripe plum and black currant. The impressive structure is readily apparent in a dense, full body with refined tannins. The extensive finish blends cassis with anise, tobacco, cocoa, and vanilla.
- Bin 1003** **Spring Valley Uriah 2013** ~ Columbia Valley, Washington **\$87**
The nose on exudes complex layers of herbs and almond paste. On the palate, it is very creamy with bright flavors of summer fruit and the fine tannins lead to a spectacularly long finish.
- Bin 1004** **The Prisoner Wine Company The Prisoner 2015** ~ Napa Valley, California **\$92**
Bold aromas of black cherry and plum are heightened by hints of oak and Madagascar vanilla. A soft and velvety palate of anise, dark cocoa powder and roasted sage lead into a dense finish with luscious tannins.

Cabernet Sauvignon

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| Bin 1101 | Josh Cellars Cabernet Sauvignon 2015 ~ California
Aromas of rich, dark fruits and baking spices on the nose, which yield fresh plum and blackberry fruit, violet, dried fig, vanilla bean, and Chinese five spice. The wine is juicy with plum and blackberry flavors prominent, roasted almonds and hazelnuts that finished long with fine firm tannins. | \$8 / \$27 |
| Bin 1102 | Freemark Abbey Cabernet Sauvignon 2013 ~ Napa Valley, California
Aromas of fresh boysenberry, blackberry pie, Bing cherry, dark chocolate, chocolate berry truffle dusted with cocoa powder, all integrated with the spicy sweetness of oak, cedar, cinnamon, clove and a hint of black pepper. | \$89 |
| Bin 1103 | Coppola Director's Cut Cabernet Sauvignon 2014 ~ Alexander Valley, California
Alexander Valley California delivers enticing aromas of cola & cherry before revealing dark, rich berry & blackberry flavors making this wine smooth & decadent. | \$46 |
| Bin 1104 | Simi Cabernet Sauvignon 2014 ~ Alexander Valley, California
Balanced flavors of red and black fruits, smooth tannins and soft spice give way to a velvety finish. | \$43 |
| Bin 1105 | Hess Collection Allomi Cabernet Sauvignon 2014 ~ Napa Valley, California
Aromas and flavors of currant and blackberry, the Allomi Cab is noted for moderate, well-integrated tannins showing a round, plush mouthfeel. Distinct notes of vanilla and oak spice from aging in American oak add to the personality of the wine, surely one of their most popular Napa offerings. | \$65 |
| Bin 1106 | Daou Vineyards Cabernet Sauvignon Reserve 2014 ~ Pasa Robles, California
Rich deep dark berry color with creamy mocha-espresso flavors. Bright acidity infused by black current and cooked blueberry fruit. Balanced and intense. | \$79 |
| Bin 1107 | Beaulieu Vineyards Rutherford Cabernet Sauvignon 2013 ~ Napa Valley, California
Briary blackberry, dark plum, black cherry, chocolate and tobacco leaf. The famous Rutherford Dust gives the wine cocoa-powder tannins and texture, while well-integrated oak adds toasty mocha notes to the generous aromas and expansive flavors. | \$58 |
| Bin 1108 | Faust Cabernet Sauvignon 2014 ~ Napa Valley, California
The aromas lift out of the glass with blackberry, black cherry, ripe raspberry and tea leaf. The entry is impressive with a fleshy mouthfeel and notes of cassis, dark chocolate and ripe berries. The layers continue to unfold throughout a long finish. | \$105 |
| Bin 1109 | Pine Ridge Cabernet Sauvignon 2014 ~ Napa Valley, California
Aromas of fresh black raspberry, boysenberry and ripe red plum, swirling with hints of red licorice, fragrant cinnamon and vanilla crème brûlée. Enchanting and luscious, the palate opens with dark ripe cherry and juicy blackberry that join with suggestions of white pepper, fresh mint leaf and berry cola. | \$95 |

Malbec

Glass / Bottle

- Bin 1201 High Note Malbec 2015 ~ Uco Valley, Argentina** \$7 / \$24
Brilliant violet color with intense, sweet spice on the palate balanced by notes of plums, cassis, blackberries, and black cherries. It is creamy, smooth, and ripe in the mouth with soft, round tannins and a long silky finish.
- Bin 1202 Don Miguel Gascon Malbec 2015 ~ Mendoza, Argentina** \$29
A full-bodied wine with aromas of blackberry, plum, & hint of mocha. Elegant & rich with a long velvety finish.

Other Interesting Reds

- Bin 1301 Ravines Cabernet Franc 2015 ~ Finger Lakes, New York** \$34
Deep ruby red color with ripe plum and red berry fruit, almost jammy, with spicy and earthy aromas. Full bodied style with very soft texture but good structure.
- Bin 1302 Ravenswood Old Vine Zinfandel 2014 ~ Sonoma, California** \$34
Made from grapes from 80 to 100 year old valley vineyards.
Soft, full, tannins, black cherry, clove, cocoa & currants.
- Bin 1303 Seghesio Zinfandel 2015 ~ Sonoma County, California** \$46
This wine that offers tantalizing raspberry, blueberry, classic briary and spicy flavors with a balance of components for which Seghesio wines are known.

Italian Reds

- Bin 1401 Leone de Castris, Salice Salentino Maiana ~ Puglia, Italy** \$30
This wine is ruby-red in color with expressive notes of ripe plum mingled with blackberry jam and sweet spice. On the palate, Maiana is full-bodied and robust.
- Bin 1401 Banfi Cantine Rosso di Toscana IGT ~ Tuscany, Italy** \$30
A blend of Sangiovese, Cabernet Sauvignon & Merlot. Soft tannins & forward fruit make this an approachable & versatile pairing with a variety of dishes.
- Bin 1402 Donnafugata "Sedara" Nero d'Avola 2013 ~ Sicily, Italy** \$32
The native grape of Sicily, Nero d'Avola shows ripe fruit aromas, soft tannins & a smooth finish.
- Bin 1403 Castellare di Castellina, Chianti Classico (2016) ~ Tuscany, Italy** \$38
This chianti pours an intense ruby red color. Notes of cherry and violet, with hints of licorice and vanilla. Balanced palate with good tannicity, and a finish of dark cherry.
- Bin 1404 Fontanafredda Serralunga d'Alba Barolo 2011 ~ Piedmont, Italy** \$115
Garnet-red color with ruby highlights that take on a slightly orange over tone over time. Intense nose with overtones of vanilla, spices, withered roses and underbrush. On the palate it is dry, full-bodied with velvety texture and great balance. It is very long lasting.
- Bin 1405 Caparzo Brunello di Montalcino 2012 ~ Tuscany, Italy** \$72
Deep garnet color with full and penetrating aromas of wild berries. The palate is dry, warm full-bodied while harmonious, delicate and austere at the same time, persistent.
