a step into History

Named in honor of Colonel Edwards Fell, the founder of Fell's Point, the inn is composed from eight adjoining buildings that have served as residences, a livery stable, a ships chandlery, vinegar bottling works, and a hospice for sailors.

The central building was a sailor's boarding house called The Anchorage, established by the Ladies Auxiliary of the Port Mission in 1900. The establishment grew, and in 1929, three annexed buildings became the Seamen's Branch YMCA. The last documented case of a young man waking to find himself "Shanghaied" on a boat bound for China is that of an overnight guest in this former boarding house.

Embrace the history of our hotel and meet some of the former occupants who have never quite left while you enjoy the Historic Ghost Tour of the Admiral Fell Inn. Our rumored benevolent ghosts include a wandering nurse and more than one sailor in her care.

ADMIRAL'S TANKARD - 5.50

Our signature drink! A Sherry and Champagne concoction based on the Admiral's secret recipe that we recently discovered inside a bottle floating in Fell's Point harbor.

1812 COCKTAIL - 9.00

In honor of the Star Spangled Banner Bicentennial Celebration! Your choice of Vodka or Gin, Lillet and a dash of Contreau – roundly shaken like a galleon on the sea – appropriately garnished with an American flag.

FORT MCHENRY - 8.50

Strong, bracing enough to withstand a siege. Admiral's Nelson Spiced Rum, lime juice, orange bitters, sparkling water, lime wedge

BOSTON TEA PARTY - 7.00

Refreshing, non-taxing, representation of a great cooler. Jack Daniels, sparkling peach iced tea, peach nectar with a peach slice

EDWARD FELL - 9.50

Historically sea-worthy, the blood and sand of Fell's Point. Scotch, Cherry Herring, Sweet Vermouth and orange juice – shaken like the waves of the sea or dashed on the rocks like a British ship storming the harbor

CAPTAIN'S GROG - 8.00

Our 1740 secret recipe of this historic drink is... dark rum, fresh lime juice, brown sugar, water, orange and a cinnamon stick

COLONIAL HARD CIDER - 7.50

Bourbon, premium unfiltered cider infused with seasonal fruit
