We are centrally located in the heart of the city centre, just a few minutes from Junction 7 of the M5 motorway, convenient for both Birmingham and Cheltenham.

From the M5 exit at J7 follow the A44 signposted for Worcester city centre. Turn right at the 6th set of traffic lights (after approx 3 miles) onto City Walls Road (dual carriageway).

Follow to the roundabout and take the last exit, following back along City Walls Road on the other side. The hotel is situated on the left hand side.

History of the Fownes Hotel

The impressive building which houses the hotel today was originally built in 1882 as a glove factory by John Fownes. The firm called Fownes Gloves was established in London in 1877 and was moved to Worcester in 1887. At that time the Fownes Gloves was one of the leading glove makers.

Following the decline of the glove industry due to fashion, the business and manufacturing of gloves was transferred to Wiltshire in 1974 and the building became derelict.

In 1985 Christine and David Hutchins acquired the site and developed the plans to convert the building into a city centre hotel.

The Fownes Hotel is now an independently owned hotel.

When you visit the Fownes Hotel there are pictures of the many processes that were involved in glove making around the building and in our reception area there is an original sewing machine which was used when the factory closed and glove making was made using outworkers.
